Directions to the Matilda Joslyn Gage Foundation High Tea and parking at the United Church of Fayetteville, 310 East Genesee Street, Fayetteville prior to a tour of the Gage Center. Starting from the Doubletree Hotel Parking Lot, turn left onto NY-298W. Immediately get into the right lane. Turn right onto Kinne Street. At the traffic light, turn left onto Franklin Park Drive. Follow Franklin Park Drive to the stop sign and turn left onto 53/Kirkville Road go passed Bishop Grimes High School. Continue on 53/Kirkville Road going through the Fly Road Traffic Light and enter I-481S ramp. Stay on I-481S by staying in the center and left lanes (make sure that you do not go onto I-690 W towards Syracuse). Drive over NY-5/Genesee Street Bridge and take Exit 3E for NY-5E/NY-92E towards Fayetteville. Once on NY-5/Genesee Street try to stay in left and center lanes as you go through two traffic lights (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light-Talbots on your right (Maple Drive), 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light-Wegmans on your left). As you approach Lyndon Corners Traffic Light, try to be in the left and center lanes. NY-5/Genesee Street (left and center lanes) splits from NY-92E (right lane goes to Manlius) at Lyndon Corners (Mobil Station at the split). Continue on NY-5/Genesee Street passed golf courses, shopping center, and car dealership for four traffic lights (Washington Street, Towne Center, Burdick, and Highbridge). As you head up the hill, pass Warren Street and take the next right onto Walnut Street (Gage Center is on corner with a small green sign in yard). Drive pass the Gage Center and the parking lot entrance for the United Church of Fayetteville Church (310 East Genesee Street) is on your left about halfway down the block. Park in the church parking lot and enter the church for the High Tea and talk. Following the High Tea, we will head over to the Gage Center for a tour. The location for the High Tea and talk had to be changed due to the large size of our group and the smallness of the Gage Center to allow all of us sitting space for the High Tea.

From the Gage Center to the Stickley Museum Tour, exit the church parking lot, turn left onto Walnut Street. Continue on Walnut Street passed the Clinton Street intersection. At the Orchard Street intersection, turn left onto Orchard Street. The Stickley Museum/Fayetteville Free Library is located on the right side of the street at 300 Orchard Street. Parking is available on either side of the building. The entrance to both the Stickley Museum and Fayetteville Free Library is located on the left side of the building. Enter the library and head straight into the library. Head straight through the 2<sup>nd</sup> set of doors towards a ramp located to the left of the Information Desk. Follow the ramp into a large open room, turn right and head toward the far right corner of the building for an elevator (a café is located in the far left corner). Take the elevator to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor for the Stickley Museum and Amanda Clifford will meet us there for the tour.

Following the Stickley Museum Tour, I suggest taking side streets to avoid rush hour traffic through Fayetteville. Turn left onto Orchard Street. Go pass both the Walnut and Warren Street Intersections until Orchard Street ends at a stop sign with Washington Street. Turn right on Washington Street for a block where the street ends. Turn left onto Mills Road and go down a hill and underneath NY-5/Genesee Street Bridge. On the other side of the bridge, turn left and head towards the Highbridge 5-way traffic light. Merge with NY-5/Genesee Street and continue through six traffic lights (Burdick, Towne Center, Washington, Lyndon Corners, Wegmans, and Maple). Enter I-481N/I-690W Ramp via the center and right lanes. Once on I-481N/I-690W stay in the right lane, avoid getting onto I-690W. Take Exit 5W -53/Kirkville Road Exit. Go through the Fly Road Traffic Light and turn right onto Franklin Pierce Drive (passed Bishop Grimes High School). At the Kinne Street Traffic Light, turn right onto Kinne Street. Turn left on NY-298W. Doubletree Hotel Parking Lot is on your right before Carrier Circle.
